

VOLUNTEER CLEARANCES

Volunteers are defined as an adult individual 18 years of age or older serving in an unpaid position who is responsible for the welfare of one or more children, or has direct contact with children through any program, activity, and service sponsored by the district or one of its schools. This includes individuals who assist a paid advisor in an extra-curricular activity. Anyone fitting into these definitions must obtain the clearances prior to volunteering.

Per NASD guidelines:

The PA Child Abuse Clearance can only be 1 year old from date of issuance. It is only FREE once every 57 months. If you have a clearance from another organization that is 366 days old, you will be charged \$13 to obtain this clearance again.
